HOMELESS PREVENTION

LINCOLN COUNTY, MAINE



Since 2010, seven local churches have addressed homelessness in Lincoln County with volunteers staffing the ECHP HELP DESK every Tuesday morning from 9 am to 11 am at the SECOND CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH in Newcastle, ME in conjunction with the weekly Food Pantry and Diaper Bank.

The **HELP DESK** operates with three guiding rules:

- Assistance is limited to housing and energy related needs;
- Recipients are limited to residents of Lincoln County, and;
- Assistance provided to the same household only once per year.



The **ECHP** meets monthly and is made up of representatives of these local churches and other related non-profit organizations in Lincoln County to help serve members of our community in need.

The HELP DESK has a close working relationship with Tedford Housing Inc, the operator of adult and family shelters in Brunswick. We have access to Homelessness Prevention Caseworkers to assist with applications for housing vouchers and subsidized housing placements.

ECHP also works very closely with our Community Navigators at the CLC YMCA to connect those in need with all the resources available to them.
